

MALLARD FENCING CLUB

BRITISH FENCING ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP

It is obligatory for all fencers to be individual members of British fencing in order to take part in any fencing activity.

Mallard fencing club must therefore ensure that all fencers at the club are individual members at the appropriate level before they are able to fence at the club.

All brand new fencers will be allowed 2 weeks grace as a taster session after which if they wish to continue they must join the British fencing association at the appropriate level.

All existing fencers or any visiting fencers must produce their membership numbers and expiry dates before being allowed to fence.

British fencing association membership details must be shown to the committee before 31st March 2011. Anyone not producing evidence by this date will no longer be able to fence at the club.

HOW TO APPLY FOR MEMBERSHIP

Go to: Membership

Decide on the level of membership required:

Full: £40 for senior

Junior: Under 20 £30

Under 13: £25

Social membership – This entitles the fencer to fence at 1 nominated registered club only and 1 local competition per year £10 This is not transferable to another level of membership at a later date.

Print off the registration details and bring along to the club as evidence of membership. These details will also need to be produced at any competitions that you later enter.
